







(8) When assembly is complete, the figure is ready to be primed and painted. Priming the metal prevents oxidation and peeling of the paints. We recommend Floquil spray primer (it's grey in color and should be available at your local hobby shop).



- (9) Now the figure is ready to be painted. We recommend Floquil and Humbrol paints be used to obtain best results. There are many painting techniques that can be used. They are described in various hobby magazines and books available through your local hobby store. Techniques like dry brushing and washes and vibrant colors yield good results after a little practice.
- (10) After the painted figure is dry, glue, it to a small balsa wood base about 3/8" or 1/4" thick for each handling during a game. You can make the base look nice by terraining it with model railroad materials such as "Kibri" grass and sand.
- (11) Finally, if you buy a set that has a broken or missing or incorrect piece, do not return the set to us. Simply drop us a postcard with your name, address and the part you need. We will ship you a replacement part.

Many Dragontooth sets come as kits that require assembly. We recommend these techniques be used by the modeler to achieve the best results:

- (1) Using an X-acto knife or rat's tail file to clean off any sprue leads or flash (thin metal feathering along the mold line.)
- (2) Check the fit of each piece (sometimes the fit changes due to the nature of the manufacturing process) and adjust with knife, file or pliers.
- (3) On our very large pieces we often use a lower tin content metal to keep prices down. This metal is not flexible when cool, like our smaller pieces. However, some degree of flexibility can be regained by holding the piece with pliers in hot (not boiling) water for a while, and bending carefully into shape with the pliers after it has heated up.


(4) Many of our parts (even heads) are interchangeable between sets. This allows a great deal of variety for the modeler.



- (5) We recommend Elmer's 5 Minute Epoxy (available through hardware stores) or a similar glue. Before mixing and applying the glue with a toothpick, as per instructions, set the pieces you will be gluing in a bed of non-hardening plasticene modeling clay. This clay will hold the pieces until the glue sets. Epoxy makes a better bond and fills small gaps better than superglue.
- (6) On larger pieces, rubber bands can be used and then cut off once the glue has set.
- (7) Further conversion and filler work on the unpainted figure can be done by using plumbers' or ribbon E-Pox-E (green & yellow). With patience, almost anything can be made from this stuff (Keep your fingers and tools wet with water).
